

EMS Upgrade Version for Communication Sites

FortiClient EMS 7.4.6 only supports upgrade from earlier 7.4 versions (see FortiClient and EMS Upgrade Path). If your current EMS version is 7.2 or earlier, see Migrating EMS 7.2 to 7.4.6.

This video shows how to configure FortiClient updates and use the auto-update feature on FortiClient EMS

After upgrading to 7.0 it should be disabled, but you have to upgrade your FortiClients to at least 7.0.2 before you enable this feature, otherwise they cannot connect.
