

Effective grounding, or earthing, of the distribution system neutral is necessary to achieve several objectives, the most important of which is the safety of the public and utility personnel.

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

It is recommended to ground the neutral at various strategic locations in distribution substations, overhead lines and underground cables, distribution transformers, and all loads.
