

How high is the bottom of the network cabinet

A network cabinet (also called a wall-mount cabinet or comms cabinet) is typically shallower and lighter than other types. In fact, these cabinets measure around 600-800 mm in depth.

The minimum spacing for the bend radius for fiber-optic cables should have the front-mounting rails of the cabinet offset from the front door by a minimum of 3 inches (7.6 cm).

The top 6U of each rack is reserved for network infrastructure, the rest of the rack for compute and storage devices. The heaviest units, like storage, should be located at the bottom of the rack.

These compact rack enclosures can house network switches, patch panels, and a small UPS system while conserving valuable floor area. Shallow depths (24-27 in) are ideal here, as they ...
