"Many" describes a large quantity of countable items or people, commonly used when the exact total isn't important or known. It is one of the most essential quantifiers in the English language, ...

We use the quantifiers much, many, a lot of, lots of to talk about quantities, amounts and degree. We can use them with a noun (as a determiner) or without a noun (as a pronoun). ...
