Small spots are best cleaned. Create a paste with one tablespoon (14.8 mL) of baking soda and 2 cups (473.2 mL) of water, and scrub the mixture over the rusty area. Alternatively, use white vinegar or lemon juice to remove the rust, then rinse and wipe the area with a damp cloth.
