

How to unplug the optical module if it s plugged in backwards

I bought a converter which came with a cable that I need to remove for return but it seems the connection at the back of the TV is locked in. I can't work out how to remove this and don't want ...

Remove the Module: While holding the latch in the released position (bail down/extended or tab slid), carefully grasp the sides of the SFP module and pull it straight out of the port using ...

Locate the optical cable you want to remove. If you have more than one optical cable plugged in, make sure you are removing the correct one or you will disconnect a different device. Grip the head of the ...

Press the optical cable connector latch down, and gently pull out the optical cable. Tip - Fully remove the cables from the transceivers. Optical equipment is sensitive. Do not leave cables partially in the ...

Avoid twisting or forcing the plug to prevent damage. If the connector feels stuck, try wiggling it slightly while pressing the tab. Regularly inspect the cable and port for dust or debris, which can cause tight fits.

The two boards were plugged in backwards at the factory. Solution: Unplug the board with the USB connector, turn it around, and carefully reinsert it into the socket.

When the question, how do you get a stuck optical cable out has been asked, the answer is pull it out, give it a tug. The questioner then responds that that hasn't worked and they had to ...

Do not force the module out without opening the pull-tab first. Doing so may damage the module or deform the host's internal locking spring, affecting future module insertion and unlocking.
