This switch has two very different modes with Static Routing set to on or off. Off means vlans on the switch are separate, ON means the switch is in effect a party line and anything goes by ...

Due to some project work, I needed to remove DHCP from one of these VLANs. Although the DHCP pool on our core is seemingly deleted/disabled (no longer shows in running-config), it is ...

Cisco IOS does not enable DHCP by default - though it may be that running SDM on the router will have DHCP. My suggestion is to look in the config of your router.

"IP Routing" is enabled on the core switch and the two access switches. These are dummy IP addresses, and the core switch is providing dhcp, so I would not need to use the "dns server" ...
