As the cable comes into the room at each end, you splice it inside a splice enclosure to a pigtail with a male-male joiner. Then buy a short patch lead to plug it into the device.

xConnect Double Pigtail - 2 in 1 cable that combines 2 cables into one lead for easier connections and wiring

Next, insert the optical fiber connector into the connector on the pigtail. You can align the fiber connector with the connection port and gently rotate the connector until it is inserted smoothly.
